Re: Halloween Parade and Fall Activity

In an effort to return to normal, Halloween parades and a fall classroom activity will be held this year on Friday, October 29th.

- Parents will be allowed to view the parades on the school property.
 - K, 1, and 2 will parade in the FRONT of the building, and
 - 3, 4, and 5 will parade in the BACK of the building.
- If there is inclement weather, the parade will be moved indoors and only staff and students will be permitted in the building.
- Students should bring their costumes to school in a bag labeled with their first and last name. *No child is permitted to wear his or her costume to school.*
- Parades will begin at 2:00 PM. After the parade, teachers will have a fall activity for students to complete in the classroom.
- There will not be any parties or food in classrooms during the Halloween event. Teachers will provide families with additional information regarding their plans for that day.

Information about costumes:

- Costumes must be school appropriate - No costumes with guns, swords, other weapons, or other inappropriate attire.
- *Students must be able to put their costume on in their classrooms and slide over the top of their clothes.* They will also need to wear their face coverings until they get outside of the building for the parade.
- Students can opt to not participate in dressing up or walking in the parade, and still attend the classroom's fall activity. We will have supervision for those students who will not participate.
- Students will have the same expectation of appropriate behavior during the activity as a normal school day.
